Holt McKeithan of Washington emerged as the first place winner of the 2016 Florence Kidder Memorial Scholarship.

Forty-six high school students from around the state applied for the scholarship. Of these, sixteen went on to receive the award.

The scholarship was awarded based on the merit of the students' original essays (75%), scholarship and community service (25%).

The essays written by McKeithan and Morris demonstrated a deep understanding of the historical account of the first president of the United States.

Established in 1923, the Florence Kidder Memorial Scholarship honors the memory of the first president of the United States.
